

LMU LAUNCHES “ZERO TOLERANCE FOR UNETHICAL PRACTICES IN EXAMINATIONS” CAMPAIGN FOR 100 LEVEL STUDENTS

The Vice-Chancellor, Professor Aize Obayan reiterated the University’s stance on best practices at the 2016/2017 Omega Semester Opening Assembly held for the 100 level students on Saturday, 7th January, 2017. In a bid to ensure total compliance with the University’s rules and regulations thereby maintaining the excellence, integrity and spirituality that define the uniqueness of Landmark University, the 100 level students were introduced to the **“Zero Tolerance for Unethical Practices in Examinations”** campaign which was launched on the 12th of January, 2016.
