Oluwakemi Erinle, Mr. Solaja, Mr. Erere Avwersuo and Mr. Femi Adetifa were nominated as members of the committee.

**Opening**

The meeting was called to order by the coordinator at 2:10pm with an opening prayer by Dr. S.K Obaniyi.

## **Coordinator's opening remark**

The coordinator welcomed all members present. He enjoined everyone to always be prompt. ### **A.O.B**

1. It was advocated that the university should make clarification on the type of grant we should apply for, since Landmark University is a faith base school.

Another member supported the suggestion made above, and added that it is important to know the specific fund that is available for research and also encouraged the group to collaborates with other institution.

### **2. How to Populate SDG-2 Exhibition Stand**

The chairman of the sub-committee explained that the machines at the exhibition stand are not for common man, they suggested cages for rabbit, chickens etc. food basket for storage. He also came up with some images, and it was concluded that the images should be sent to our individual mail at the end of the meeting.

Another Member of the house said the issue of populating our stand should come after we have designed our own research, he advised that the first thing to do is how to go about solving the problem of zero hunger.

### **3. Formation of Research Clusters**

The coordinator explained that one of the items in the terms of reference said we should have research clusters, therefore it is pertinent to form clusters, he advocated that the house should make suggestions on how to go about the cluster formation.

A member of the house suggested we should form a committee to create the clusters, and then individual should choose from the clusters.

Another member added that the group should interact with the community in order to know the type of seed they are using to plant, so that it can be integrated into our research in other to distribute it to farmers around.

It was also added that group should be created based on our area of specialization.

The coordinator concluded that clusters will be created and that members can join anyone that suits them. He also stressed that members can join more than one clusters

A member asked if the group is for research or practical, he said if it is for research then we can all engage in the practical aspect. He added that the engineers among us will design, and everyone will function based on their area of specialization. In the same vein he advised that we need to see how problems on hunger can be solved, he said we should look in to poultry and fishery farming, and explained that Central bank of Nigeria is giving out loan to people. He further said that as a group, we can draft our proposal and send it to CBN, he advised us to see beyond theory, and get our own land, to farm and process.

The coordinator responded that the terms of reference is more of practical, he said a committee that will encompass all our area of specialization should be constituted, he asked the assistant coordinator to form the committee.

The assistant coordinator suggested Dr. Oluba, Dr. Iseolorunkanmi, Dr. Okeniyi, Dr. Ajide and Engrn Aniyi as the member of the committee where Engrn Aniyi was appointed as the head of the sub-committee. The suggestion was accepted by the house.

The assistant coordinator explained that the committee will be the one to create clusters for SDG 2.

The house suggested that the committee should have their meeting, as soon as possible so that the clusters would have been created before our next meeting. The head of the committee concluded that they will be holding their meeting on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of August 2020.
